

Public Transport

The Senior Secondary Student Concession Card is issued free of charge for the initial issue and is valid for the year of issue, and then until 31 March the following year. A replacement fee is payable for any replacement card. Holders of this concession card are entitled to half-price fares and can apply for a Child/Youth Opal card.



School OPAL card

Rotary Exchange Students are eligible to free student travel passes if they meet the same requirements applicable to NSW school students. The AASES form helps verify they are entitled to the same rights as Australian students. (Live more than 2 km from school)



- Free travel to and from school on approved trains, buses and ferries with the School Opal card (on school days during specific times 6.30am – 7pm)
- Registered address is more than 2km from school
- **Step 1.** Parents (or students aged 16 or over) first fill in the [online application form](https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/applyNow).
- **Step 2.** Print and sign the form and submit to the school for endorsement.
- **Step 3.** The school will then forward the application to Transport for NSW for processing. If the application is approved a School Opal card will be sent to the address given in the application form.

Child/Youth OPAL Card

Get your Child/Youth Opal card over the counter. Remember to have your Proof of Age Concession or NSW Senior Secondary Student Concession Card available.
